SPECIAL RELEASE NOTES

The following are the special notes related to this release cycle of InterAct RMS version 10.20.1.

BROWSER SUPPORT

GOOGLE CHROME

Google Chrome is the recommended browser for those customers still running Internet Explorer 8 on Windows XP. In the past release cycle, Google upgrade Chrome support to version 42 which introduced a problem to some customers trying to use our attachment up-loader and signature pad capture tools

In Chrome version 42, Google has begun the transition to end support for NPAPI which will occur in Chrome version 45. What this means is that Google Chrome will no longer support 3rd party applet plugins in version 45 due to security exposures that this plug-in architecture brings.

The Interact RMS will not be impacted by this transition by the time Google Chrome version 45 come to market. However, we currently still use the NPAPI architecture for our attachment up-loader and signature pad capture tools.

To prevent any potential issue using the attachment up-loader and signature pad capture tools that are available within InterAct RMS, customers are required to enable NPAPI support in Google Chrome 42 and later.

Enabling NPAPI in Chrome Version 42 and later

As of Chrome Version 42, an additional configuration step is required to continue using NPAPI plug-ins.

- In your URL bar, enter: chrome://flags/#enable-npapi
- 2. Click the **Enable** link for the **Enable NPAPI** configuration option.
- 3. Click the **Relaunch Now** button that now appears at the bottom of the configuration page.
- 4. You may need to also allow browser plugins to run for Java. If you see a red x in the right of the URL bar click and select to allow to always enable for InterAct.

Please Note: If you are running 64-bit Google Chrome, you may be required to also install 64-bit JAVA in order for the NPAPI plug-ins architecture to work going forward.

CJIS SECURITY RULE IMPLEMENTATION

USER ACCOUNT INACTIVITY

In order to align the NLETS hosted InterAct RMS security guidelines with the CJIS Security requirements, a change to the RMS User "Inactivity" period will be implemented starting on May 15th, 2015.

The default user inactivity period will be set to 90 days for all users in all schemas per the CJIS security policy rule for managing user identifiers. If a user has not logged in after specified period of inactivity, then the user's identity and authorization to access the system needs to be confirmed by the agency administrator.

The value of 90 days aligns with the period CJIS has mandated for password changes. The assumption is if the person has not logged into the InterAct RMS within the last 90 days then the agency system admin will need to confirm the user's identity.

The account expiration days can be adjusted lower per schema by InterAct if required but they are not to exceed 90 days.

Reference below the CJIS policy driving this change:

CJIS Security Policy 5.6.3.1 Identifier Management

In order to manage user identifiers, agencies shall:

- 1. Uniquely identify each user.
- 2. Verify the identity of each user.
- 3. Receive authorization to issue a user identifier from an appropriate agency official.
- 4. Issue the user identifier to the intended party.
- 5. Disable the user identifier after a specified period of inactivity.
- 6. Archive user identifiers.
